INVITATION FOR BIDS (IFB)

DEVELOPMENT OF ASSET MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (SUPPLY AND INSTALLATION OF CUSTOMIZED SOFTWARE) FRDP/2016/ICB/G/02

1. This Invitation for Bids (IFB) follows the General Procurement Notice (GPN) for Federal Roads Development Project (FRDP) that appeared in *Development Business* dated **11 March, 2005**.

2. The Federal Government of Nigeria *has received a credit* from the *International Development Association (IDA)* in the sum of USD 330 million toward the cost of Federal Roads Development Project (FRDP), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this *credit* to payments under the agreement(s) resulting from this IFB: *The Development of Asset Management System (Supply And Installation of Customized Software) – FRDP/2016/ICB/G/02*

3. The *Road Sector Development Team (RSDT)* serves as the implementing agency for the project and now invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for *The Development of Asset Management System (Supply and Installation of Customized Software)*. *The Development of Asset Management System (Supply and Installation of Customized Software)* will offer a broad range of technology services to Road Asset Management Stakeholders in and outside the Federal Ministry of Power, Works and Housing and its Agencies, including the general public. The *Customized Software* will be an integrated and collaborative ecosystem of digital information assets and technology services for delivering an effective and comprehensive Road Asset Management. The customized software consists of an integrated solution:

A portal-based solution which provides the standard access to secured and unsecured RAMS related digital information of assets and systems while enforcing strict compliance to business processes as well as asset master data availability, integrity, independence, protection, preservation, usage-consistency and overall agility in the customized software.

The bidder shall also include the cost of support of the supplied customized software over an initial five years, and on a Provisional Sum basis, the cost of hosting the Portal at the FGN Data Centre for five (5) years and related IT infrastructure.

4. Bidding will be conducted using the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures specified in the World Bank's *Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers 2011 revised 2014* ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest, and is open to all Bidders eligible as defined in these Guidelines, that meet the following minimum evaluation criteria:

(a) *The key qualification criteria relating to previous experience, financial capacity, etc., from the BDS entry for ITB Clause 6.1 (a)].*

(b) *It is expected that the bidder's off the shelf solution shall meet as much as possible the Client's functional and technical specification without customization. This will be one of the key evaluation criteria.*

© *The Responsive Bidder would be invited to demonstrate how well their off the shelf system meets the functional and technical specifications.*

Financial Capability:

The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence that it meets the following financial requirement(s): **The audited accounts for the last three years 2013, 2014 and 2015 shall be submitted to demonstrate the current soundness of the bidder's financial position.**

(b) Experience and Technical Capacity

The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence to demonstrate that it meets the following experience requirement(s):

i. A minimum of two complete life cycles (from requirements through implementation and commission) projects in the supply of similar *Information Systems* and related services. One of the projects should be at least USD 300,000.00

ii. The minimum turnover of the Bidder in the last five years should be about USD 4,000,000.00

5. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information and inspect the bidding documents at the Office of the Unit Manager, Road Sector Development Team (RSDT) at the address below on working days from 10:00 hrs to 17:00 hrs (local time).

6. A complete set of Bidding Documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written Application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **₦15,000** (Fifteen thousand Naira) only. The method of payment will be by **REMITTA** in favour of "**Road Sector Development Team**". Bidding Documents will be available from February 16, 2017. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 12 noon on March 30, 2017. Electronic bidding will *not* be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend in person at the address below at 12.00pm on March 30, 2017.

7. Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before 12.00 noon on March 30, 2017. **"Bids need to be secured by a bid security, "The amount of Bid Security required is USD 50,000.00.** Electronic bidding will *not* be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below at 12.00 noon on March 30, 2017.

8. The attention of prospective Bidders is drawn to (i) the fact that they will be required to certify in their bids that all software is either covered by a valid license or was produced by the Bidder and (ii) that violations are considered fraud, which can result in ineligibility to be awarded World Bank-financed contracts.
